## TLI 21616 Certificate II in Warehousing Operations Online Learning

<b>The Program</b>	This course is suited to persons who are commencing a career in the Warehousing Industry or have had a career change. The course covers the introductory units of working in a warehouse and may be working under direct supervision. There are <b>16 Units of Competency</b> to be studied and assessed to receive the qualification. Most students complete this study in 3 months.
<b>Training Arrangement</b>	The 16 units of competency are delivered online. Recognition of prior learning (RPL) or Credit Transfer (CT) is available to students who can demonstrate competency in these units. There are practical components, so employment or access to a workplace is required.
<b>Fees For Course</b>	This program is delivered in three blocks to complete the full Certificate II Qualification. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Block 1 (5 units) \$310.00</b></li> <li>• <b>Block 2 (5 units) \$310.00</b></li> <li>• <b>Block 3 (6 units) \$375.00</b></li> </ul> <p>The full course fee being <b>\$995.00 (GST exempt)</b>. The course can also be paid on a per unit basis at \$65 per unit.</p>
<b>Program Content 16 Units Required</b>	Units offered are from the Transport & Logistics Training Package and from other nominated Packages. The College of Warehousing will work with you to negotiate a training program with timelines to meet the specific needs of the learner.
