Fatigue Management Courses – 2016

Driver fatigue laws apply to all heavy vehicles throughout Australia. Fatigue is regulated by NHVAS and enforced by State and Territory authorities.

A heavy vehicle is:

- a vehicle with a Gross Vehicle Mass (GVM) of over 12t
- a combination when the total of the GVM is over 12t
- buses fitted to carry more than 12 adults (including the driver)



TLIF2010 – Apply Fatigue Management Strategies [Truck driver's course] Online

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to apply fatigue management strategies within the transport and logistics industry. Work is undertaken in compliance with relevant legislation, regulations, codes and guidelines. It includes identifying signs of fatigue, legislation, diet, lifestyle, BFM, work & rest, medicals and use of a work diary.

TLIF3063 – Administer implementation of fatigue management strategies [Scheduler's course] Online *pre-requisite TLIF2010

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to administer fatigue management policies and procedures in a workplace in accordance with NVHAS Authority, State/territory legislation and Regulations. It includes monitoring the signs of fatigue, scheduling driver's work and rest, apply six (6) Standards of accreditation for SFM, BMF, AFM, driver competency, medicals, driver lifestyle, diet, auditing work dairies and record management.

TLIF4064 – Manage fatigue management policy and procedures [Manager's course] Online

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to manage fatigue management policy and procedures in accordance with 10 Standards, relevant legislation & regulations. Course includes legal requirements, liabilities and responsibilities for improving fatigue management plans, policies and procedures. It includes operational systems are compliant and adequate operational systems and training of staff on fatigue management techniques within the clients chain of responsibility.

Chain of responsibility courses also available. They are nationally recognised and comply with the unit of competency from the Transport and Logistics Industry training package.
